RMDSTEM Completes Infrastructure Review for Ivanhoe Australia

RMDSTEM recently completed an infrastructure review for Ivanhoe Australia Limited's (IAL) Cloncurry Project.

IAL, which recently floated on the Australian Securities Exchange, has a series of copper/gold deposits near Cloncurry, in north Queensland. In order to bring the deposits into production, IAL asked RMDSTEM to develop a roadmap of the infrastructure requirements for the project. The review extended to transport, power, water, sulphuric acid and accommodation facilities. Also included was what level of interaction would be required with the Queensland government.

The review was led by Andrew Robertson, one of RMDSTEM's senior project management consultants. After Andrew had presented his findings to the Ivanhoe management team, General Manager Development, Barry Goss emailed him to say, "Great job on infrastructure ... just what we wanted."
